Prospectus instructions

- (1) A prospectus of your final paper is due April 14 by the beginning of class.
- (2) Substantive restrictions:
 - a. Your prospectus should describe what your paper will be about *very* clearly.
 - b. Make sure to say what your hypothesis is.
 - c. Make sure to say where you will get your data.
- (3) Formal restrictions:
 - a. It must be typed double-spaced in a reasonable-sized font.
 - b. It cannot exceed *one* page.
 - c. It really is due at the beginning of class on April 14.
